THE STORY: A modern romantic comedy about a marriage, a midlife crisis - and a dog.

Greg and Kate have moved to Manhattan after twenty-two years of child-raising in the suburbs. Greg's career as a financial trader is winding down, while Kate's career, as a public-school English teacher, is beginning to offer more opportunities. Greg brings home a dog he found in the park—or that has found him—bearing only the name "Sylvia" on her name tag. A street-smart mixture of Lab and poodle, Sylvia becomes a major bone of contention between husband and wife. Sylvia offers Greg an escape from the frustrations of his job and the unknowns of middle age. To Kate, Sylvia becomes a rival for affection. And Sylvia thinks Kate just doesn't understand the relationship between man and dog. The marriage is put in serious jeopardy until, after a series of hilarious and touching complications, Greg and Kate learn to compromise, and Sylvia becomes a valued part of their lives.

## **ROLES AND CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS:**

**GREG** – (appearing age 42-65) A middle-aged financial trader who finds a stray dog and falls in love. He loves his wife, but hates his job and is going through some sort of mid life crisis. He thinks Sylvia is the answer to all of his problems.

**KATE –** (appearing age 42-65) A middle-aged school teacher whose career is on the upswing after raising kids and mioving to Manhattan. She enjoys the freedom of empty nesting and resents Sylvia's presence in their lives.

**SYLVIA** – (appearing younger than 42) A street-smart, sexy labradoodle who finds the master of her dreams in Greg. Sylvia is energetic, a little naughty, and full of wonderment. She pushes the boundaries whenever possible, is equally demanding and endearing. She is like a two-year-old having an adorably fun day.

**THREE OTHER CHARACTERS –** (appearing about the same age as Kate) **TOM**, a philosophical dog-lover in the park; **PHYLLIS**, an old Vassar classmate of Kate's; and **LESLIE**, a marriage counselor whose therapy is based on his/her being utterly androgynous. \*These characters may be cast separately, (or may all be played by the same actor.)
